# Swiss Fairy Tale

**Day 1 Zurich**  
 Arrival in Zurich and transfer to the hotel.

**Day 2 Zurich - Rhine Falls & Stein am Rhein - Zurich**  
 Enjoy of a regular excursion to the spectacular Northern Switzerland. Discover the stunning Rhine Falls, Europe's biggest waterfall followed by the visit of the medieval town of Stein am Rhein. It is famous for its well-preserved Old Town featuring painted facades and half-timbered houses, for which it received the very first Wakker Prize in 1972, awarded by the Swiss Heritage Society.

**Day 3 Zurich - Lucerne - Bern**  
 The first part of your train journey will be to the beautiful city of Lucerne, meet your local guide at the train station for a short walk through this ancient city where you will find the oldest covered bridges in Europe, as well as cobbled streets, Baroque churches and houses full of history. Then continue your trip by train to Bern.

**Day 4 Bern**  
 After breakfast, meet your local guide at the Lobby for a short walk through the city. Not many cities have managed to retain their historic features quite as successfully as Bern, the capital of Switzerland. The old town of Bern is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and thanks to its 6 kilometers of arcades - the locals refer to them as 'Lauben' - boasts on of the longest weather-sheltered shopping promenades in Europe.

**Day 5 Bern - Montreux**  
 After breakfast, the journey continues by train to Montreux. Free time to discover the city. The town of Montreux nestles in a sheltered Lake Geneva bay, surrounded by vineyards and against the breathtaking backdrop of snow-covered Alps.

**Day 6 Montreux - Geneva**  
 The journey continues by train to Geneva. Free time to discover the city. Embedded between nearby Alpine peaks and the hilly terrain of the Jura, the French-speaking city of Geneva lies in the bay where the Rhone leaves Lake Ge-

neva. With its humanitarian tradition and cosmopolitan flair, the European seat of the UNO and headquarters of the Red Cross is known as the «capital of peace».

**Day 7 Geneva - Chamonix-Mont-Blanc - Geneva**  
 Enjoy of a regular excursion to Chamonix. Drive by bus through the picturesque Arve Valley which takes you from Geneva to Chamonix, one of the most famous mountain villages at the foot of the remarkable and majestic Mont-Blanc, the highest peak of Europe (4.807 meters).

**Day 8 Geneva - Zurich**  
 Free time to enjoy the city. Then travel by train to Zurich.
