Culinary Germany in winter

Day 1 Frankfurt - Heidelberg
 Arrival at Frankfurt airport and trip to Heidelberg. The banks of the Neckar River give away in Heidelberg one of the postcards most admired by the fans of German Romanticism. In the evening enjoy a dinner in one of its typical restaurants.

Day 2 Heidelberg
 Visit of the city, historic center of Heidelberg is well preserved, where you will find several churches, such as the Heiliggeistkirche (Church of the Holy Spirit), and many baroque buildings. Then visit the Castle, this impressive medieval work is located on top of a hill from which you can see the entire Neckar valley. Then visit a wine tasting at the Vinothek in the historic basement of the Heidelberg castle.

Day 3 Heidelberg - Hohenzollern - Lake Constance
 In the morning travel from Heidelberg to Lindau. The road winds its way through the Black Forest. Stop at the castle Hohenzollern where you can try a real Swabian specialty: "Kässpätzle", a special type of pasta with cheese. Afterwards continue to the small island of Lindau in Lake Constance, which

offers spectacular views of the Alps. In the evening enjoy a wine tasting.

Day 4 Lake Contance - Munich
 Today you leave Germany's wine region and reach the capital of Bavaria, famous for its beer culture as well as for hearty meals. Upon arrival in Munich enjoy a sightseeing tour of the city including the most famous attractions such as the elegant Marienplatz with its famous clock tower. In the evening you have a real Bavarian experience: dinner at a local and authentic Bavarian restaurant where you can try a Bavarian "Schweinshaxe" (pork knuckle) with beer.

Day 5 Munich
 You will learn more about the Bavarian capital and its main attractions, such as the famous Viktualienmarkt, a big street market with a huge variety of fresh food and delicatessen. You also visit the beer museum where you can learn more about the history of beer in Munich from the beginning to the present. Then you will go to the Giesinger Bräustüberl (Bar of the Giesinger Brewery) to taste a test of 3 beers on tap (0,1l).

Day 6 Munich - Nuremberg
 After breakfast, travel to Nuremberg and visit the old town of Nuremberg to see the important history of the city with its impressive and well-preserved castle, Gothic churches, romantic houses and quiet squares that create an unforgettable atmosphere. Then enjoy the famous sausages during lunch. The sausages of Nuremberg or nürnbergerer have the distinction of being the smallest in Germany.

Day 7 Nuremberg - Rothenburg - Frankfurt
 After breakfast leave the city and head for Rothenburg, one of the oldest and most beautiful cities along the Romantic Road. Sightseeing tour of this lovely medieval town concluding with a tasting of a Schneeball (snowball), a dessert considered the characteristic dish of Rothenburg. The tour ends in Frankfurt.
