Christmas Markets & castles



Day 1 Frankfurt
Arrival at Frankfurt airport and transfer to your hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore at your leisure.

Day 2 Frankfurt - Würzburg - Rothenburg
Travel from Frankfurt to Würzburg and enjoy a sightseeing tour of this city. Würzburg's city center has been designated a UNESCO Heritage Site. Then continue to Rothenburg ob der Tauber, one of the oldest and most beautiful cities in Roman-

tic Germany. Its small streets and historic buildings take us back to medieval times. Tour the city and visit the Christmas market.

Day 3 Rothenburg - Nuremberg
In morning you are free to soak up the atmosphere of Rothenburg. Make sure to visit the shop of Käthe Wohlfahrt, internationally renowned for its great assortment of Christmas crafts. Continue to Nuremberg for a city tour. The Christmas

market in Nuremberg, known as „Christkindlesmarkt“ is the most famous of all markets in Germany. With almost 400 years of history, the market draws more than 2 million visitors a year.

Day 4 Nuremberg - Regensburg - Munich
Continue to the city of Regensburg. Founded by the Romans, this is one of the oldest cities in Germany and has been designated a UNESCO Heritage Site. After a sightseeing tour, continue to Munich. Munich combines

the atmosphere of a charming historic city with that of a modern metropolis. Visit the city's main attractions, including the Marienplatz square, the historic City Hall and the Christmas market.

Day 5 Munich - Garmisch-Partenkirchen - Füssen
Travel to Garmisch-Partenkirchen and visit Germany's winter sports capital and site of the 1936 winter Olympics. Optional excursion to the top of Zugspitze, Germany's highest mountain (2.963 m). Depending on the weather conditions, you may enjoy amazing views of a snow-capped Zugspitze. In the afternoon continue to Füssen at the foot of the mountain range.

Day 6 Füssen - Neuschwanstein - Stuttgart
Neuschwanstein castle is one of the most famous castles in the world. Built by Ludwig II, the castle served as the inspiration to Walt Disney's castle of Sleeping Beauty. After the visit continue to Stuttgart, the capital of the state of Baden-Württemberg. Home to the head office of Mercedes-Benz and Porsche, Stuttgart lies in a valley surrounded by vineyards.

Day 7 Stuttgart - Heidelberg - Frankfurt
In the morning visit the Mercedes-Benz museum and
