The Black Forest in winter

Day 1 Frankfurt - Baden-Baden

In the morning transfer to Baden-Baden, the former summer residence of the European nobility and known worldwide for its thermal baths. Another one of its attractions is the casino, nestled at the foot of the black forest. Visit the city and its surroundings. As an optional excursion, spend a few hours relaxing in the famous classic Friedrichsbad spa or in the modern Caracalla Therme baths in Baden-Baden.

Day 2 Baden-Baden - Titi Lake - Freiburg

Continue the tour to Freudenstadt traveling along the high road through the Black Forest, taking in magnificent views of forest and canyons. Then visit Ti-

tisee, the glacial lake in the heart of the Black Forest. We take a brief stop at Hofgut Sternen to learn more about the fascinating world of cuckoo clocks. Afternoon arrival in Freiburg and sightseeing tour of the city.

Day 3 Freiburg - Colmar - Strasbourg

The river Rhine forms a natural border between Germany and France. After crossing the Rhine, you will arrive in Colmar, France. This city is famous for its wines and architectural heritage that reflect the region's long history and the many different influences. Continue to Strasbourg, the capital of the Alsace. Enjoy a sightseeing tour of the city.

Day 4 Strasbourg - Heidelberg - Frankfurt

Travel to Heidelberg to visit the famous castle. This beautiful university town is one of Germany's oldest and one of its most popular destinations. Then continue to Frankfurt. Afternoon arrival in Frankfurt and transfer to the airport or hotel.
